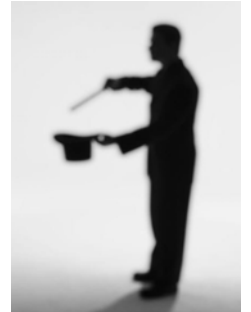

My Dear Friends in Christ,

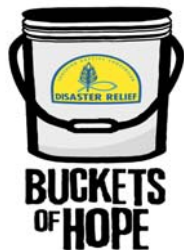
