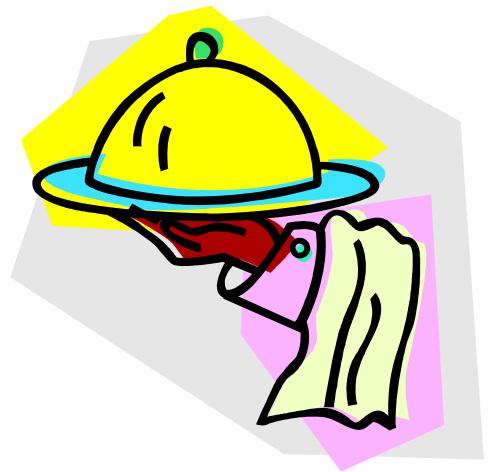

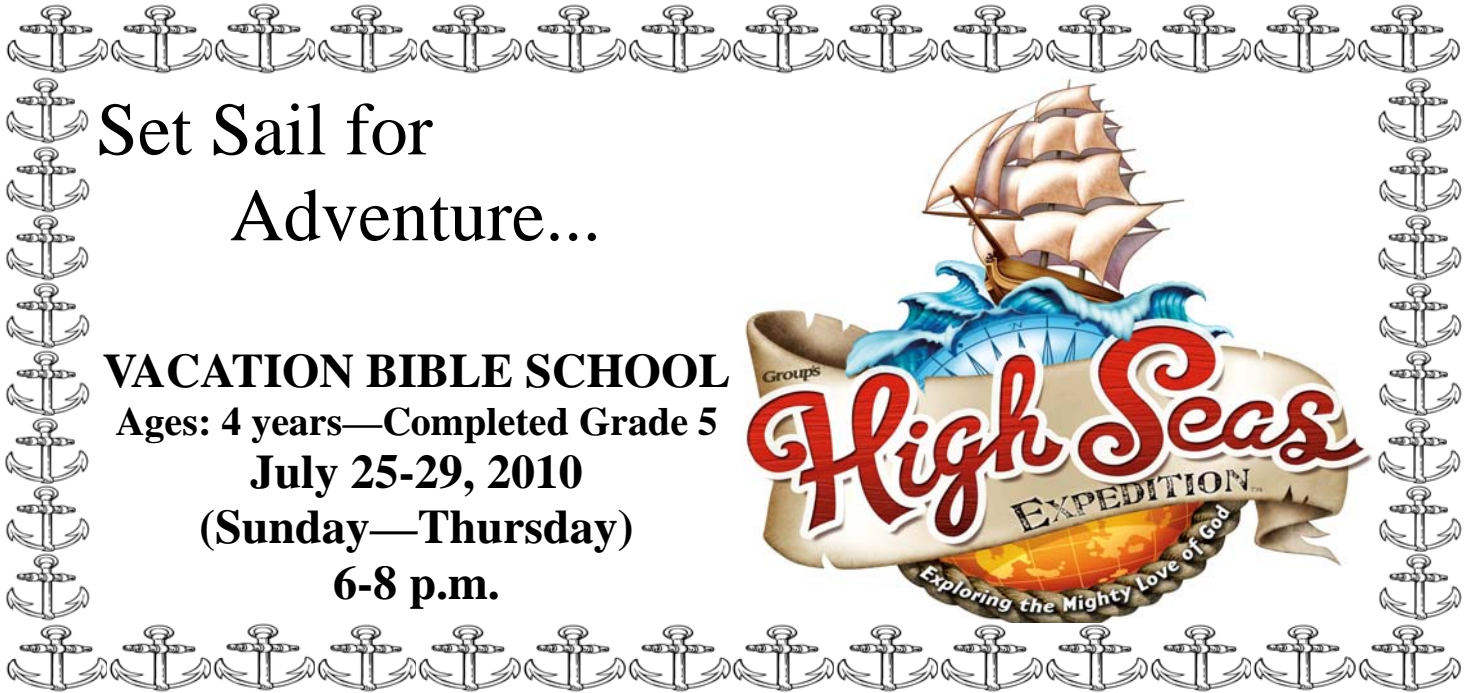
FAITH IN ACTION
